EMRHA Year End Award Rules

TO BE ELIGIBLE:

- 1. ARHA rules prevail.
- 2. Riders of horses competing for EMRHA awards must be members in good standing, with EMRHA.
- 3. Horse & Rider combinations must be nominated for year-end awards. For OPEN ONLY points will follow the horse for high points. Versatility will be based on horse & rider Combo. A Nomination form must be filled out and submitted with the appropriate fees prior to any points being accrued for year-end awards. This form is available on the website www.emrha.com or at an event.
- 4. No points or money earned can be recognized before receipt of current dues and the nomination form and nomination fee. Once both forms are received points will accrue for the remainder of the season.
- 5. To be eligible for year-end show awards you must attend one meeting and participate in at least three EMRHA sponsored shows in the calendar year. For versatility year-end awards you must have versatility points at three shows.
- 6. Leadline & Walk/Jog 14 & Under Riders do not need to nominate or attend a specified number of shows or meetings. Year-end awards will be based upon show participation.

MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING:

- 1. The definition of a member in good standing is a member who has paid their yearly dues.
- 2. A member who has been suspended by ARHA will be automatically suspended by EMRHA.

SHOW POINTS:

- 1. Will be compiled by the Show Secretaries.
- 2. Awards are based on a one rider / one horse combination, with the exception of Walk/Jog 14 & Under & Leadline.
